COMMUNION SERVERS

Are you interested in helping to serve communion?



Anyone who has been ordained as a deacon or ruling elder is eligible to do so; you don't have to be currently serving. We celebrate the Lord's Supper by serving communion on the first Sunday of each month. We alternate between intinction (people come forward, take a piece of bread, dip it in the chalice of grape juice, and return to their pews), which requires 6 to 8 servers, and passing plates (first of bread, then of cups of juice) along the pews, which requires 10 servers.

We also celebrate the Lord's Supper on Maundy Thursday, three days before Easter, and at the 11 p.m. service on Christmas.

KITCHEN NEWS

The refrigerator and freezer have undergone a cleaning on the inside and shelves have been relabeled.

Helpful reminders:

- 1) Please make sure you are labeling ALL items with group name and date and place on proper shelf.
- 2) Please do not leave leftovers (this includes Coffee Hour goodies) for a group or staff and assume they will use them. Check with a member from the group first before leaving it on their shelf.
- 3) Items that are expired or spoiled will be discarded.
- 4) Cream cannot be set out for use and then put back in the fridge for reuse on another day. Once cream goes out to the coffee area, any left-over cream should be discarded.
- 5) If you spill something in the fridge

please wipe up the spill and all shelves under it, all the way to the bottom.

6) Freezer items should be properly sealed in bags or airtight containers to avoid freezer burn. Throwing some plastic wrap on a plate of cookies and placing in the freezer won't work.

These tips will help everyone not to waste items and keep our fridge and freezer clean.

The back counter by the microwave is not for permanent storage. Items not labeled and left for over two weeks will be donated. This includes miscellaneous dishes and bags.
