KMCC History Notes

That beautiful, old fashion house, on the corner of 2nd and Grove Street was built in 1900 to be the First Presbyterian Church of Parma.

The pulpit and choir were in the East end of the building. Movable chairs were grouped for Sunday School and then arranged in straight rows for the preaching service. Long wooden benches, in the rear and near the entrance, were used by late comers or those in a hurry to leave. A coal burning stove on the north side furnished heat and kerosene lamps were used for evening services.

The steeple over the entrance to the sanctuary contained a large bell rung by pulling a rope. The bell could be heard as far away as Roswell, calling worshipers to the many church services each week, and if needed, a fire-alarm.

An organ was used which was pumped by foot power. Later a piano was purchased, leading to our next month story.
